Question 4: Did you do gymnastics when you were little?

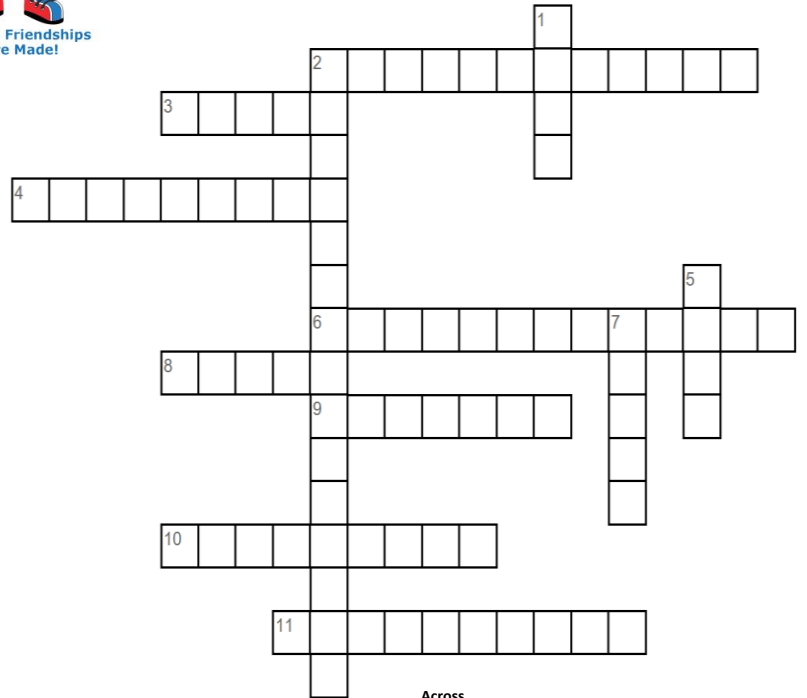
Answer: Yes! I've been a gymnast since I was 4 years old and then when I was 10 I started competitive cheerleading.

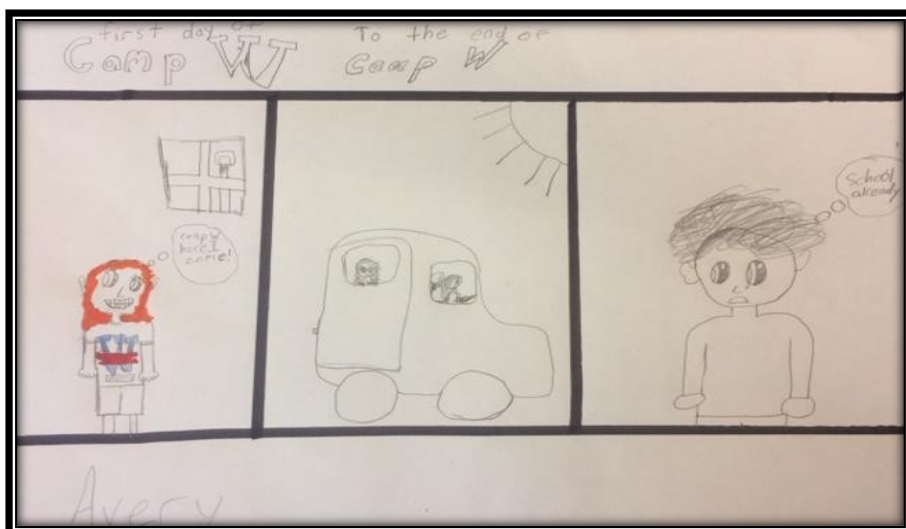
