There were 2 bounce houses, there were 2 obstacle courses, and a gaga pit. there was even a cotton candy machine and a face painting station run by Kristen!!

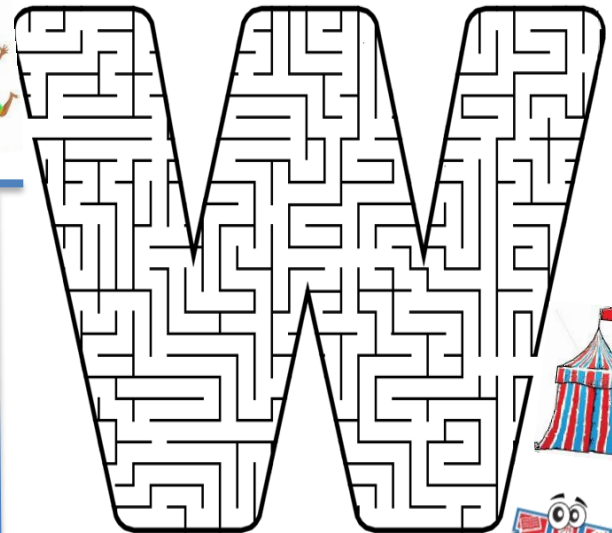

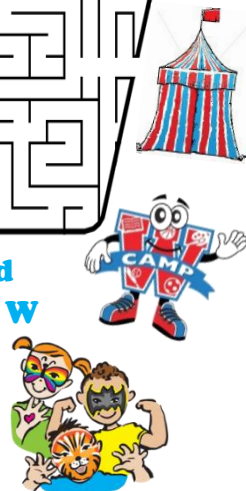
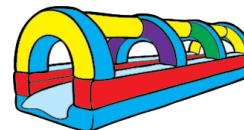
