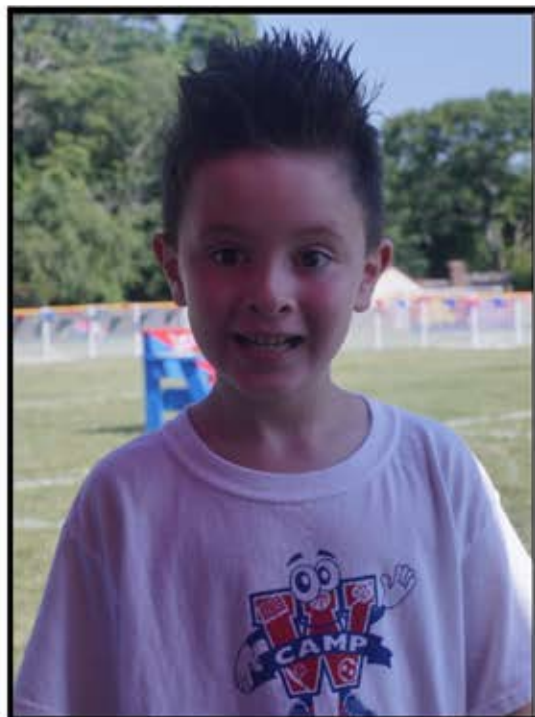


Crazy Hair Day!
