Camp W, "where friendships are made" located in Melville, NY, is a summer day camp that offers a broad range of activities for campers, Pre-K - 9th grade.

Kiddie Camp:

Pre-K - 1st Grade

Group sizes average 12 campers in a group with a counselor and two assistant counselors. Each group has a set schedule with activities including athletics, creative arts and other unique activities.
